

Henry John Meyer, 77

Irwin — Henry John Meyer, son of Henry W. and Bertha Saltwell Meyer was born Oct. 6, 1900, on a farm near Manilla in Shelby county. He attended the rural schools near his home and later farmed with his parents and raised cattle. He married Myrtle Ahrenholtz Cox on Febr. 3, 1957. They continued to farm on the home place until moving into Manilla on Nov. of 1971. Henry was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church in Manilla. He has been ill since the first of the year and following a long hospitalization in Omaha moved to the Manilla Manor, April 26, 1978, where he died Monday eve., July 10, 1978 at age 77 years, nine months and four days.

He was preceded in death by his parents, by four brothers and one sister. He is survived by his wife, Myrtle and the following children: Eunice, (Mrs Lyle) Mansfield of Maxwell; Doris (Mrs Clifford) Klein of Harlan; Don Ahrenholtz of Ft. Collins, Colo.; Joanne (Mrs Arthur) Meyer of Atlantic, by 25 grandchildren, three great grandchildren, and one brother, Louie Meyer of Grants Pass, Oreg., and other relatives.
