

David O. Moody, 67

Irwin — David O. Moody, son of Joseph and Rose Mease Moody, was born Nov. 10, 1910 near Audubon. He attended the rural schools near his home and graduated from the Audubon high school. He married Irene Wilson on Aug 24, 1941. They farmed in Audubon county after their marriage. David was a member of the United Methodist church in Gray. He was a member of the Audubon County Farm Bureau for many years, serving on the executive board and also as county president. He was active in community affairs both in the Manning and Audubon communities. David died at the Manning General hospital on Wednesday, April 26, 1978, at age 67 years, 5 months and 16 days.
