HARLAN — Marie Virginia More, daughter of Richard H. and Margaret Robinson Pleasants, was born in Alexandria, Va., on Dec. 19, 1912. She attended school and grew to adulthood in Alexandria. On June 11, 1938, she married Keith More in Alexandria, Va. Three daughters were born to this union. After their marriage, Mr and Mrs More settled in Harlan, and this has been her home since that time. Mrs More died at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan on Mar. 7, 1977, at age 64 years, two months and 18 days. She was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal church in Harlan. She was also a member of the Lebanon Chapter No. 8, O.E.S., the P.E.O. Sisterhood, the American Legion Auxiliary and the V.F.W. Auxiliary, all of Harlan.

She was preceded in death by her father; a grandson, David Lynn Gilliland; and by two sisters, Mrs Fanny McDonough and Mrs Lilly Bryan. Her survivors include her husband, Keith More, of Harlan; three daughters - Margaret (Mrs George Gilliland) of Blair, Nebr., Jean (Mrs Dave Ranum) of Macon, Mo., and Elizabeth (Mrs Dale Larsen) of Harlan; and by eight grandchildren, by her mother, Mrs Margaret Pleasants of the Little Flower Haven in Earling; her aunt, Mrs Lucy Connelly of Alexandria, Va.; nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at Pauley Funeral home in Harlan on Wednesday, March 9, 1977 with the Rev. Glenn E. Rankin, rector of St. Paul's Episcopal church in Harlan, officiating.
