**FRED T. MCGARRY, 77**

**PANAMA** — Fred Thomas

McGarry, son of James M. and Mary Loos McGarry, was born Dec. 6, 1896 in Chicago, Ill. He died at Myrtle Memorial hospital on Sept. 23, 1974 at age 77 years, 9 months, 17 days. He attended school and grew to adulthood in Congress Park, Ill. He served his country during WWI. After his discharge in Dec. of 1918, he returned to Chicago, Ill., where he worked as a supervisor for the Frigidaire Co. Oct. 22, 1941 he married Emilie Domhan in Chicago and they continued to make their home there. After Mr McGarry's retirement in Dec. of 1962, they moved to Panama, and this has been his home since that time. He has been a member of St. Mary's church in Panama since moving to that community.

Mrs McGarry was preceded in death by his wife, Emilie on Mar. 31, 1964 by his parents and by his sister, Margaret (Mrs Albin Domhan). He is survived by one brother Raymond J. McGarry of Fort Lauderdale, Fla., by three nieces, Margaret (Mrs Jack Struyk) of Omaha, Nebr., Corabelle (Mrs Arthur Preston) of Weatherford, Ten., and Raymonda (Mrs William Fulton) of Barrington, Ill., and other relatives.

A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated on Thursday, Sept. 26, 1974 at St. Mary's church in Panama with Rev Fred P. Reischl as celebrant. Msgr M.B. Schiltz and Father Paul Koch attended the funeral. Father Paul assisted in the distribution of Holy Communion. Burial was in St. Mary's cemetery in Panama with Jack Struyk Jr., Thomas Struyk, Bob Goetz, Roger Goetz, Greg Schwery and Roger Assmann, serving as pallbearers.
