

# Mrs Olive Nelson, 81

S. C. — Mrs Olive Nelson, daughter of Frankie Sisson and Aaron McCuen was born Jan. 28, 1897 in Audubon county. She died Saturday, April 22, 1978 at the Charleston Nursing Center, Mount Pleasant, So. Ca. at age 81 years, 2 months and 24 days. Olive was educated in the rural Audubon schools. On Oct. 14, 1915 she married James P. Nelson in Audubon. They farmed in Audubon county and later moved to Audubon, where James worked with the Iowa Highway Commission. In 1935 they moved to Calif. due to her health. She spent about 35 years in Calif. before moving to Cross, S.C., to be with her sister, Hazel Lund. Olive was confirmed Dec. 9, 1934 and was a member of St. Michael's Lutheran, Moncks Corner, S.C.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband - James P. Nelson, one daughter - Muriel Irene Hollembeck, 3 brothers - Charles, Arthur and Walter and one sister in infancy. Survivors include one grandson - Michael Hollembeck of Stockton, Cal., son-in-law - J. D. Hollembeck of Stockton, Calif., one brother - Roy McCuen of El Monte, Calif., one sister - Hazel Lund of Cross, S.C., brother-in-law - Henry Nelson of Harlan, sister-in-law - Nina Norgaard of Harlan and nieces and nephews and other relatives.
