

## Charles Nicodemus

Funeral services for Charles F. Nicodemus Jr., 29, of Minden, will be at 3 p.m. Saturday at the Meyer Funeral Home.

The Rev. Neal Zeilinger, pastor of St. Paul's Lutheran Church of Neola, will officiate. Burial will be in St. Paul's Church Cemetery in Boomer Township.

Nicodemus was fatally injured in a motorcycle accident Thursday on a county road near Minden. He was pronounced dead on arrival at a Council Bluffs hospital.

He was born in Waukegan, Ill., and resided most of his life in Des Moines, moving to Underwood in 1972. He moved to Minden eight months ago from Council Bluffs.

Nicodemus was owner of the Old Post Office Saloon at Underwood.

**MINDEN** — Charles Nicodemus, 29, Minden, was killed early Thursday (July 8) when the motorcycle he was driving veered out of control near Minden.

Pottawattamie county sheriff's deputies said the motorcycle was northbound on county road L-66 one-half mile north of Minden about 2:40 a.m. when it traveled about 250 feet along a gravel shoulder and into the ditch.

He was pronounced dead on arrival at Jennie Edmundson Hospital in Council Bluffs. He is survived by his wife, Lela.
