Mabel Nordby, daughter of Anna Ronfeldt and Nick Hansen was born April 11, 1909 at Irwin. She attended rural school near Irwin. On Dec. 20, 1931, she married Arlo Nordby at Irwin. They farmed in the Irwin area for 31 years. Following their separation, she moved to Harlan and operated her apartment and worked for a couple of years at Mickel's restaurant. She died at the Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines on Sept. 25, 1984, at the age of 75 years, 5 months and 14 days.
