**MRS LOUIS PAOLLAZZI, 79**

**WESTPHALIA** — Rosa Paollazzi, daughter of Maria Anna and Martin Zimmerman was born Feb. 6, 1895 in Germany. She died at Myrtue Memorial hospital on July 20, 1974, at age 79 years, 5 months, 14 days. As a young woman, she came to the U.S. and made her home in the Westphalia community. It was here that she married Louis Paollazzi at the St. Boniface church on Nov. 25, 1924. Two daughters were born to this union. After their marriage, Mr and Mrs Paollazzi continued to make their home in Westphalia. She has been a member of St. Boniface church since coming to Westphalia and she was also a member of St. Boniface Rosary Society.

Mrs Paollazzi was preceded in death by her husband, Louis, on Sept. 1, 1962; by her parents; infant twin brothers; and one sister - Sr. Lambert, O.S.F. She is survived by her daughters - Mary Paollazzi, who made her home with her mother in Westphalia, and Madonna (Mrs Raymond Nowatzke) of Earling; by seven grandchildren; one great grandson; one sister - Sr. Benincasa, O.S.F. of Cambellsport, Wisc.; a half brother - Martin Zimmerman of Westphalia and other relatives.

A Concelebrated Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated at St. Boniface church in Westphalia on Tuesday, July 23, 1974 with Rev. James A. Freeman as celebrant and Rev. Gary Culver as concelebrant.
