Lamond Alton Petersen, son of Annabelle Maxwell and Raymond Petersen was born June 25, 1950, at Harlan. He attended Jackson twp. rural school and graduated from the Harlan Community high school in 1969, where he was active in the wrestling program. He was baptized and confirmed at the Bethlehem Lutheran church. For the past 12 years he worked as a heavy equipment operator on construction, except for one and a half years when he sold welding equipment and supplies.

He has fought injuries and ill health most of his life and was most eager to help others who were less fortunate. He enjoyed old cars and collected DeSotes. He died at Jennie Edmundson hospital in Co. Bluffs at the age of 32 years, 8 months and 14 days.

He is survived by his parents: Anabelle and Raymond Petersen of rural Harlan; one brother Ronald of Audubon; two sisters: Mrs Beverly Cox of Valley, Neb. and Mrs Marlene Wahl of Omaha. He is also survived by six nephews, one niece and other relatives and his very dear friends. Wayne and Roxanne Nevel, with whom he made his home for the past two years.

Funeral services were held Saturday, March 12, 1983 at the Bethlehem Lutheran church with Pastor Oliver Solberg officiating. Harlan police reported Petersen had suffered an aneurism when the vehicle he was operating collided with an unoccupied, legally-parked vehicle.

The Petersen vehicle, a '75 Ford, collided with a parked '80 Chevrolet owned by Ralph W. Little, Harlan, at 4:20 p.m. Tuesday, just south of Seventh

and Durant Sts. Total property damage estimate was placed at \$600.

Petersen was unconscious at the scene and transported by Medivac ambulance personnel to Myrtue Memorial Hospital, then transferred to the Council Bluffs hospital.

He was a heavy equipment operator during the past 12 years, and sold welding equipment. He was a 1969 graduate of Harlan Community High School, where he participated in wrestling.

Surviving are his parents, Raymond and Anabelle Petersen, of Rt. 2, Harlan; a brother, Ronald of Audubon; and two sisters, Mrs. Beverly Cox of Valley, Nebr., and Mrs. Marlene Wahl of Omaha.
