K. Boyd Phillips, 74

Kenneth boyd Phillips, son of Harry A. and Belle Palmer Phillips was born May 22, 1909, east of Hancock and reared in the Atlantic vicinity.

He was married to Leta Neumann on May 19, 1935. They farmed in the Atlantic area many years and had three children. He was a 50-year ember of Zion Evangelical Lutheran church in Atlantic.

In 1976 the couple moved to Walnut, where he became active in civic affairs and members of the Walnut Saddle club. He was a past member of the Walnut city council and of the Walnut water board. He was a member of the Walnut Community club and Walnut Creek Historical Society and transferred church membership to Our Savior's Lutheran church in Walnut. Following a long illness he died Oct. 4, 1983 at Cass co. Memorial hospital, Atlantic at the age of 74 years.
