

THE LIFE STORY OF —

FLORENCE M. PHILSON, 68

Florence Marie Philson, daughter of Ethel M. Pine and William C. Mallonee was born March 23, 1908 in Fremont, Nebr. She died April 6, 1976 at Jennie Edmundson hospital, Co. Bluffs at age 68 years and 13 days. Mrs Philson attended school at Fremont, Nebr., and Harlan and graduated from the Harlan high school in 1926. She married Lowell E. Philson on July 3, 1929 at Harlan and to this union four children were born. They have formed in Shelby county for 47 years and would have celebrated their 47th wedding anniversary this year. For many years she has been a member of the Congregational United Church of Christ Priscilla's Guild and Christian Education. She was also a member of Zenobia Rebekah Lodge No. 286, Harlan.

Florence was preceded in death by her parents, one son - Arthur, in infancy and one sister - Mrs Clara Steele. Survivors include her husband - Lowell of Harlan, three daughters: twins - Shari (Mrs James Peacock) of Nixa, Mo., Shannon (Mrs Glenn Core) of Bloomington, Minn., and Bonnie (Mrs Alfred Jensen) of St. Pete Beach, Fla., and by seven grandchildren.
