## Arlene Rasmussen

Arlene Elizabeth Rasmussen, daughter of Harry and Meta Cook Malick, was born on a farm near Cuppy's Grove in Monroe twp., Shelby county, on Feb. 9, 1915. She attended country school and later graduated from the Harlan Community high school. She grew up to adulthood on her parent's farm. On June 14, 1932, she married to

Malvern Rasmussen at Logan. Two daughters were born to this union. After their marriage, Mr and Mrs Rasmussen made their home in Harlan, where they owned and operated a restaurant for a few years. They also ran the concession stand at the Swimming Pool Park for over 20 years. Mrs Rasmussen had been employed as a clerk at Farner's since 1972. She was baptized in the Altamont Baptist church in 1933 and had been a member of the First Baptist church in Harlan for many years. She died at Nebraska Methodist hospital in Omaha, Neb., on Oct. 10, 1976, at age 61 years, 8 months and one day.

She was preceded in death by her parents. She is survived by her husband, Malvern, of Woodbine; her daughters - Joanne (Mrs Dewey Andersen) of Hinsdale, Ill., and Jean (Mrs Dale Findlay) of Woodbine and by three grandchildren, by two brothers - Gather Malick of Co. Bluffs and Gerald Malick of Denison; a sister, Ethel (Mrs Paul Fischer) of Omaha; nieces and nephews; and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at First Baptist church in Harlan on Wednesday, October 13, 1976 with Pastor C. Donald Thrash, pastor of the First Baptist church, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery, with Don Malick,
