

THE LIFE STORY OF—

Peter Rasmussen

KIMBALLTON — Peter Rasmussen was born Aug. 28, 1902 at Brayton, son of Rasmus and Marie Hansen Rasmussen. He was baptized and confirmed at Oak Hill Lutheran church. He was a member of Immanuel Lutheran church. Peter was educated in rural Audubon county schools and attended Grand View College in Des Moines. On Sept. 20, 1923 he married Lydia Faaborg at the Johannes Faaborg home. They farmed in Audubon county and in 1969 moved to Elk Horn. Peter died at Cass County Memorial hospital in Atlantic on Sunday, Sept. 26, 1976 at 74 years.

Peter was preceded in death by his wife, Lydia in 1973. He is survived by three daughters: Irene (Mrs Wendell) Larsen, of Elk Horn; Harriet (Mrs Robert) Campbell of Hamlin and Shirley (Mrs Martin C.) Nelson of Elk Horn; nine grandchildren, four great grandchildren and three sisters - Mathilda Johnson, Marie Brown and Edna Johnson, all of Brayton.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, Sept. 29, 1976 in the Immanuel Lutheran church in Kimballton with Pastor David L. Peterson, officiating. Burial was in the Elk Horn Lutheran cemetery with Darrell Soe, Hans Johnson, Dale Jensen, Everett Brown, Gail L. Johnson and Leroy Plagman serving as casket-bearers.
