

Eva E. Robinson, 81

Irwin — Eva E. Robinson, daughter of Benjamin and Sarah Holden Evans, was born on a farm near Emerson, Nebr., on May 11, 1897. She attended country school and grew to adulthood on her parent's farm.

On Dec. 6, 1916, she married Louis H. Robinson in Emerson, Nebr. Three children were born to this union. After their marriage, Mr and Mrs Robinson made their home in Emerson and later in Ponca, Nebr. Around 1930 they moved to South Sioux City, Nebr. After Mr Robinson's death in 1961, Eva moved to Harlan and this has been her home since that time. Mrs Robinson died at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan, Sunday, Nov. 5, 1978, at age 81 years, five months and 24 days.

In addition to her parents and her husband, she was preceded in death by a daughter, Norma Kazos; a son, Archie H. Robinson; ten brothers - Lester, Emanuel, Frank, Edward, Aaron, Clyde, Roy, Elmer, David and Harry Evans; and by three sisters - Alice, Mary and Myrtle Evans. She is survived by a daughter, Hazel E. Robertson, of Florissant, Mo.; seven grandchildren; nine great-grandchildren; nieces and nephews and other relatives.
