

Sister M. Louis Rosmann, O.S.F., 68

Wisconsin — Sister M. Louis Rosmann (Anna Helen) daughter of Joseph and Rose Hodapp Rosmann, was born Feb. 1, 1912. She was baptized and confirmed in St. Boniface church, Westphalia. She grew up on a farm in Lincoln twp. and attended public grade school. At age 15, she entered St. Joseph's Convent, Sisters of St. Francis in Milwaukee, Wisc. She became a nurse and worked in physical therapy for several years, later regular nursing duty and desk clerk at Sacred Heart hospital near the convent. She celebrated her 50 year jubilee as a nun Aug. 21, 1977 at St. Boniface church, Westphalia.

She suffered a heart attack on Tuesday, Dec. 23, 1980 and died the same day at St. Luke's hospital, Milwaukee, Wisc., at age 68 years.

She is survived by one brother, Leonard of Harlan, a sister-in-law, Mrs. Ellen Rosmann of Harlan, five nephews, two nieces, and other relatives. She was preceded in death by her parents, a sister Adeline, who died in Aug., 1972, two brothers - Ray and Walter.

A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated at St. Joseph's Convent Chapel in Milwaukee, Wisc., on Sunday, Dec. 28, 1980. Burial was in Mt. Olivet cemetery in
