

Wilbert Schraiter, 71

Nebr. — Wilbert Henry Schraiter, son of Dora Schutt and Henry Schraiter was born July 20, 1909 in Manilla. He died Monday, Aug. 11, 1980 at Clarkson hospital, Omaha at age of 71 years and 22 days.

Wilbert was educated in the Manilla rural schools. He married Majorie Ingram Johnson on June 25, 1945 in Co. Bluffs. They farmed in the Manilla area until 1957, when they moved to Ralston, Neb., for three years. In 1960 they farmed near Shenandoah for seven years before moving to Millard, Neb. in 1967. Wilbert was baptized in the Manilla Lutheran church and was a farmer for most of his life.

He was preceded in death by his parents, two sisters - Mrs Milfred West and Mrs Eileen Eischied. Survivors include his wife - Marjorie of Omaha, three daughters - Mrs Sharon Burmeister of Harlan; Mrs Connie DeBord and Mrs Joni White both of Omaha; four sisters - Mrs Kate Suiter and Mrs Helen Duncan, both of Co. Bluffs; Mrs Ida Farley of Defiance and Mrs Florence Farley of Manilla; by five grandchildren, nieces, nephews and other relatives.
