

Brion K. Sick, 22

SHELBY — Brion Kim Sick, the son of Wilbert and Maxine Sorensen Sick, was born in San Antonio, Texas on April 14, 1956. As a young child, he moved with his parents to a farm west of Shelby. This was their home until Feb. of 1959 when they moved to their present home northwest of Shelby.

Brion attended school in Shelby and grew to adulthood on his parent's farm. From 1975 to 1976 he attended Shasta College in Redding, Calif. He then returned to Shelby and was employed with G. A. Finley, Inc. of Harlan. Brion died accidentally on June 29, 1978, in Harlan at age 22 years, two months and 15 days.

He was preceded in death by his paternal grandparents and his maternal grandfather. His survivors include his parents, Mr and Mrs Wilbert Sick of rural Shelby; a brother, Wade, at home; a sister, Tammy, at home; his maternal grandmother, Mrs Ejner Sorensen of Wheat Ridge, Colo.; and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at Shelby Lutheran church in Shelby, on Saturday, July 1, 1978, with Pastor Mary Peterson Drennan, officiating.

Burial was in the Shelby cemetery, with Roger Paul, Greg Nauman and Neil Pauley serving as honorarybearers and Don Jensen, Mike Krohn, Tim Barrett, Tom M. Stoker, David Wahling and Russ Redinbaugh serving as casketbearers.
