Manning — William Soll, son of Frederick and Weike Vollert Soll, was born April 19, 1887 in Kolzunge, Schleswig-Holstein, Germany. He came to the U.S. in May of 1907.

He married Dora Boyens on Dec. 18, 1912. Nine children were born to this union. They farmed near Halburn, Manning and Manilla until moving to Aspinwall in 1938. In 1972 they celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary. Dora died in 1974. William continued to make his home in Aspinwall until moving to the Manilla Manor in June of 1976. He entered St. Anthony's hospital in Carroll, this is where he died Wednesday, Dec. 12, 1979 at age 92 years, 7 months and 23 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, Dora; by one daughter, Hazel and one son, William. Survivors include his children: Ernest Soll of Vancouver, Wash.; Andrew Soll of Manilla; Arnold Soll of Elk Horn, Esther Stief of North Bend, Oreg.; Lester Soll of Vancouver, Wash.; Roy Soll of Aspinwall and Frances Soll of Carroll; by 20 grandchildren, 54 great grandchildren and four great great grandchildren, nieces, nephews and other relatives.
