Dominic "Mick" Tierno II, son of Dominic and Phyllis Sutphin Tierno, was born July 21, 1965, in Harlan. Mick attended school in Harlan and was a member of the junior class at Harlan Community high school. As a student, he participated in athletics, concentrating on track, wrestling and football.
