EDWARD TRAMM, 95

Walnut — Edward Tramm was born May 9, 1880 in Shelby county, son of Hans and Rosa Jensen Tramm. In 1906 he married Dora Johannsen and they farmed northwest of Walnut. One son was born to this union. In 1921 they moved to Walnut, where he served on the town council for 12 years and continued to manage his farm interests. Mrs Tramm died in 1963. He suffered a severe accident in 1967 and lived in the Oakland Manor since then. This is where he died Thursday, Feb. 5, 1976 at age 95 years.

He was preceded in death by his son Gilbert, two brothers and two sisters. Survivors include a daughter-in-law Mrs Gilbert Tramm of Kankakee, Ill., two grandsons, Tom of Chicago and Edwin of Kankakee, and one granddaughter, Mrs Martha Beaumont of Urbana, Ill., and nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held Saturday, Feb. 7, 1976 at the Berthusen-Knudsen Funeral Home in Walnut with Rev Wayne Selsor, officiating. Casketbearers were Edwin Tramm, Tom Tramm, Paul Simonsen, Donald Holtz, George Hansen and Everette Reimer. Burial was in the Walnut cemetery.
