Kimballton — Edward Emil Wad was born April 3, 1919 in Audubon county, son of Thorvald and Mable Andersen Wad. He was baptized and confirmed at the Ebenezer Lutheran church in Audubon county. He was currently a member of the Immanuel Lutheran church in Kimballton.

On March 17, 1946 he married Oda Hansen. He worked in the Kimballton area all his married life; including the Western Iowa Pork Plant in Harlan and for several construction companies. He died Thursday, April 16, 1981 in St. Joseph's hospital, Omaha, Neb., at age 62 years.
