# Thamer Warren, 84

Thamer Thomas Warren, son of Anna Brannen and Alfred Warren was born March 9, 1898, at Runnells. He was educated in the rural Adelphi, schools, attended Graceland College at Lamoni and graduated from Iowa State University at Ames in 1932, majoring in Farm Crops and Soils.

On June 15, 1935 he married Ila Ruth Visser at Rock Port, Mo. He worked for 12 years for the Iowa State Soil Conservation Services as a agronomist in Shelby, Page, Harrison and Crawford counties. He farmed near Irwin for 18 years and moved to Harlan in 1964, where he worked part time for Farners store for a number of years.

He was a member of the First United Methodist church of Harlan and died Tuesday, Feb. 8, 1983 at the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn at the age of 84 years, 10 months and 29 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents, four brothers: Harold, Alvord, Clifford and Kenneth. Survivors include his wife Ila of Harlan; son, Thomas A. Warren of Laguna Hills, Calif.; two sisters: Mrs Dorothy Clark of St. Mary's and Mrs Margie Wagner of Des Moines. He is also survived by one grandson, many nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Thursday, Feb. 10, 1983, at the Burmeister Funeral Home with Dr. Larry LaVelle, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Bill Warren, Larry Warren, David Warren, Michael Clark, Donald Warren, Karroll Warren and Steven Wagner serving as casketbearers.
