

## Anna Weis, 92

Anna Weis, daughter of Matthew and Catherine Strunk Weis, was born Feb. 25, 1890 on a farm near Earling. She was baptized, received her First Communion and confirmation at St. Joseph's Catholic church in Earling. She attended the country school near her home, growing to adulthood helping on the family farm. She then taught at country schools in the Shelby co. area for some years. When her parents became elderly, she returned home and cared for them until they died. She then moved into Defiance, where she lived for many years. In 1975, she became a resident of the Little Flower Haven Nursing Home in Earling. This has been her home since that time. Miss Weis was a member of St. Peter's Catholic church in Defiance.

She died at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan on Wednesday, Dec. 8, 1982, having attained the age of 92 years, 9 months and 13 days.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by one brother, Joseph Weis and five sisters, Katie Klocke, Frances Reding, Mary Lypold and Lucy and Lena Weis. She is survived by one brother, Alex Weis of Denison; nieces, nephews and other relatives.
