Elk Horn — Anna Wells, daughter of Lars and Ane Katrine Larsen, was born Nov. 29, 1901 on a farm near Elk Horn. She attended country school and the Elk Horn College. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran church.

On May 2, 1921 she married Royal H. Wells. This union was blessed with four children. After their marriage they lived in Exira until she moved to Elk Horn in 1958. She worked as a nurses aid in the Salem Lutheran Home for ten years. She died at the Salem Nursing Home in Elk Horn on Sunday, Feb. 25, 1979 at age 77 years, 2 months and 26 days.

She was preceded in death by one son-Robert, a grandson, Steven Petersen; her brothers and sisters, Johannes Larsen, Metha Larsen, Karen Marie Larsen and Andreas Larsen.
