Alice Norma Wilcox, daughter of Eola Pulver and Harry Buckman was born February 17, 1907 in Shelby County, Iowa. She died April 13, 1971 at the Myrtue Memorial Hospital, Harlan at the age of 64 years, one month and 26 days. She married Eugene Wilcox September 25, 1936 at Rock Port, Missouri. Mrs Wilcox was raised in Shelby County, educated in the Harlan School System and a Harlan area resident all of her life. She was a member of the Harlan United Methodist Church and Zenobia Rebekah Lodge 286.
