

# Charles E. Winsor, 78

Irwin — Charles Everett Winsor, son of Mr and Mrs George Winsor, was born March 24, 1900, in Olyney, Ill. He attended the rural schools in Ill., and as a young boy came to the Irwin community. He later was a herdsman for Escher and Ryan who specialized in the black Angus cattle. He married Dagmar Jensen on March 25, 1924. After living one year in Missouri, they moved to a farm near Irwin and for the past 34 years have lived on the present home place. Charlie had been ill for four weeks and at that time entered St. Anthony hospital in Carroll. About one week ago he was taken to Methodist hospital in Omaha, where he died Sunday, July 9, 1978 at age 78 years, 3 months and 15 days. Charlie was a member of the Methodist church in Irwin.

He was preceded in death by his parents, by three brothers and one sister.
