**MRS HAZEL C. YACKEY, 83**

Hazel Crique Yackey, daughter of Minnie Amster Swartz and Joseph Crique, was born May 27, 1888 at Harlan, Iowa, and lived her entire life in this community. She died at her home in Harlan on August 22, 1971 at age 83 years, 2 months, and 26 days.

On Oct. 29, 1915 she married Joseph N. Sanchez. To this union was born one daughter, Vivian Ile. On Dec. 22, 1923 she married Hiram V. Yackey. He passed away in May of 1946.

Mrs Yackey was a lifetime member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church of Harlan and St. Catherine's Guild of this Church. She was a member of Zenobia Rebekah Lodge No. 286 of Harlan and was a Past Noble Grand of this Lodge, also a fifty-year member. A memorial service was conducted by Zenobia Rebekah Lodge at 8:30 p.m. Wednesday at Pauley Funeral Home.

She was a past president of the Women's Relief Corp (auxiliary to the G.A.R.). She received "The Superior Club of Accomplishment Award" as the 1958-59 president of the Women's Union affiliate of The Iowa Federation of Women's Clubs. She was a member of the Harlan Civic Club and Shelby County Historical Society.

She is survived by her daughter, Mrs Vivian C. deCanter of Miami, Florida; a step-son H. V. Yackey, Jr. of Chicago, Illinois, and two step daughters - Mrs Evelyn Goodell of Long Beach, Calif. and Mrs Hazel Brodersen; by two cousins - Mrs Katherine Ranum of Austin, Minnesota and Mr Dent Z. Holcomb of Grand Island, Nebraska, and other relatives.

Funeral services were Thursday, August 26, 1971 at 11:00 a.m. at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Harlan with the Rev. Glenn E. Rankin officiating. Interment was in Harlan Cemetery with Keith More, Arthur Nielsen, Bruce W. Ouren, Orrell Gearhart, H. W. Ouren, Jr., and Dean Frederickson serving as casket bearers.
