WESTPHALIA — Mark Aloysius Zimmerman, son of Roman and Patricia Sullivan Zimmerman was born in Manilla on April 23, 1957. He died at his home in Omaha, Nebr., on Aug. 23, 1977 at age 20 years and four months. He was baptized and confirmed at the Sacred Heart Catholic church in Manilla. He grew up in Manilla, attending grade school and the Manilla high school through his junior year. He then attended Kuemper high school in Carroll, where he graduated in 1975. Mark attended North West Missouri State College in Maryville, Mo., for a year before moving to Omaha, Nebr., in the fall of 1976. This has been his home since that time. He was a member of the Sacred Heart Catholic church in Manilla.

He was preceded in death by his mother. His survivors include his father and step-mother, Mr and Mrs Roman Zimmerman of Oakland, five brothers - Joseph of Des Moines, Melvin of LaVista, Nebr., James of Baldwin City, Kans., Elmer of Sioux City and Gerald of Ralston, Nebr., two nephews, Mike and Steve and other relatives.

A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated at St. Boniface Catholic church in Westphalia, on Friday, Aug. 26, 1977, with Rev. Joseph A. Devlin, pastor of St. Mary's church in Red Oak, as celebrant.
