## **Myron O. Albers, 58**

**PERSIA** – Myron O. Albers was born Aug. 13, 1932 in Co. Bluffs. His parents were Ora and Alda Albers. He died June 9, 1990 at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan of an apparent heart attack. He was an Army veteran who spent 17 months in Korea during the Korean conflict as a sergeant in Artillery Battalion.

He married Lois Hoffman March 4, 1956. Four children were born to this union. He was employed by D.L. Hughes Trucking in Persia, for 16 years, and employed by the Iowa Department of Transportation in Neola for 19 years.

He was preceded in death by his father, Ora.
