Feb. 17, 1895 — Sept. 7, 1991

DENVER, CO. - (Inger) Margrethe Andersen, daughter of Lauritz and Johanne (Jensen) Andersen, was born Feb. 17, 1895, in Godthaab, Denmark. In June of 1912, in order to be near immediate family members, she, her widowed mother, and younger sister emigrated to Harlan. For several years, Margrethe was employed as a housemaid in the homes of prominent business persons in Harlan before moving to Denver, CO., to pursue a similar occupation there. She died at Wheat Ridge Manor Nursing Home in Wheat Ridge, CO., Sept. 7, 1991, at age 96 years, six months and 20 days.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by two sisters, Marie Brogden and Mette Spiesberger; three brothers, James, Ed, and Mike Andersen; one niece and two nephews. She is survived by eight nieces and 12 nephews.

The body was cremated. A graveside service was held at the Cuppy's Grove cemetery Sept. 28, 1991, with Pastor David Erickson, officiating. Pauley Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
