HARLAN — Irma Johanna Andersen, daughter of Soren and Johanna Sorensen, was born Sept. 27, 1925, near Fiscus. She was raised near Fiscus, and graduated from Audubon High School in 1943. In 1945, she moved to Harlan with her parents.

Dec. 25, 1946, she married Robert C. Andersen at her parents. After their marriage, they farmed east of Harlan for 36 years. In 1984, they retired from farming and moved into Harlan.
