Harlan - Jeanne Louise Andersen, daughter of Edwin and Virginia (Dull) Sanderson was born July 15, 1936 in Omaha, NE. She attended elementary school and graduated from high school in Omaha. In May of 1948, she was baptized at Grace Baptist Church in Omaha. After school she was employed at Milder Oil in Omaha and

for a short time at the Bank of America in Riverside, CA.

Jan. 17, 1958 she married Donald R. Andersen in Omaha. Four sons were born to this union. After their marriage, they farmed in Monroe Township. After his death Aug. 5, 1977, she moved to Harlan where she was employed as a Librarian Aide in the Harlan Middle School and then for KNOD Radio in Harlan. She then became employed by the Harlan National Bank, and had recently been an employee of CDS in Harlan. She was a member of Grace Baptist Church when residing in Omaha, and was presently a member of the Calvary Baptist Church in Walnut. She died at her home in Harlan April 10, 1995 at age 58 years, eight months and 26 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents and husband. Surviving are her children, Wade (Dawn) Andersen of Omaha; Scott (Beth) Andersen of Monroe; Eric Andersen of Co. Bluffs and Cole (Michelle) Andersen of Harlan; four grandchildren and a brother Bob (Sandy) Sanderson of Papillion, NE and other relatives.
