Jan. 10, 1924 - Sept. 30, 1996

HARLAN - Louisa Anna Andersen, daughter of Atman and Anna (Andersen) Kohl, was born Jan. 10, 1924, in Cass Township, Shelby County. She was raised near Tennant and graduated from Tennant high school in 1942.

She married Raymond Andersen Feb. 18, 1946, in Co. Bluffs. The couple made their home in Harlan, where she was active with the VFW #941 Auxiliary, and regularly helped with the Bloodmobile. She died Sept. 30, 1996, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 72 years, eight months and 20 days.

Preceding her in death were her parents and one brother, William Kohl. Survivors include her husband, Raymond Andersen of Harlan; one brother, Warren Kohl of Defiance; two sisters, Pearl Kinney of Overland Park, KS and Betty Christiansen of Pueblo, CO; one sister-in-law, Rose Kohl of Woodbine, and many nieces and nephews.
