## **Hannah E. Anderson, 97**

**Nov. 6, 1893 – Dec. 26, 1990**

**CHEROKEE** – Hannah E. Anderson, daughter of Anton and Anna Louise Swanson Anderson, was born Nov. 6, 1893 near Woodward. After she graduated from high school she attended Drake University.

Sept. 3, 1930, she married Dr. LeRoy Anderson at Gowrie. She taught country school in the Gowrie area for many years and also worked for the city of Des Moines. After living in Des Moines, they moved to Harlan, Pipestone, Mn., and finally Cherokee where she was a member of the Open Bible Chapel. She died Dec. 26, 1990 at her grandson's home in Cherokee after a long illness.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Dr. LeRoy Anderson in 1961; one daughter, Joyce Simms, four sisters and one brother. Survivors include one grandson, Mark G. Simms of Cherokee; one granddaughter, Ramona Lucius of San Marcos, TX., and six great-grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Dec. 28, 1990 at the Boothby Funeral Home in Cherokee with Rev. Gerald Pettit of Jefferson, officiating. Burial was in the Highland Memory Gardens cemetery in Des Moines. Boothby Funeral Home of Cherokee in charge of arrangements.
