SHELBY — Edwin Barney Arp was born near Tennant Jan. 26, 1927. He was the son of Ferdinand and Kathrine Schultz Arp and was the youngest of five children in the family. His mother died when he was six months old. He was raised by Matt and Dora Pauley who were friends of the family. He attended school in Tennant and graduated in 1944. He served in the Marine Corps during WW II. When he returned from the service, he worked for the Earl May Store and E.M. Christensen Appliance, both in Harlan. He then went into the television repair business.

He married Darlene Troll Aug. 3, 1952 at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Harlan. They were the parents of 3 children, Debra, Sharon and Bruce. He remained active in the t.v. repair business until his health began to fail. He was a member of the United Lutheran Church of Shelby and the Shelby Fire Department. The past week he has been a resident of the Little Flower Haven Nursing Home in Earling. He died at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan, July 16, 1993, at 66 years, 5 months and 21 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents. Survivors are his wife, Darlene, their children, Debra (Roger) Grant of Omaha, NE.; Sharon (Terry) Weis of Treynor; and Bruce Arp of Avoca; 7 grandchildren; 2 sisters, Lillian (Lawrence) Kolterman of Tennant; Martha (Raymond) Petersen of Jacksonville; 2 brothers, Walter Arp (Lucille) of Harlan; Grant Arp (Darlene) of Carpenter, WY.; nieces, nephews and other relatives.
