BRAXTON, MS — Kevin Dean Ahrenholtz, the son of Galen and Judy Sunderland Ahrenholtz, was born Dec. 11, 1965, at Harlan. He attended Harlan Community Schools and was a member of the graduating class of 1984 from Harlan Community High School. After graduation, he attended Wayne State College in Wayne, NE for a year and a half. Kevin then enlisted into the United States Air Force. He attended basic training at Lackland Air Force Base in Texas. He was stationed at Elgin Air Force Base in Fort Walton Beach, FL and was honorably discharged.
