

## Helen Albers, 82

*May 6, 1922 - Nov. 28, 2004*

**MODESTO, CA** —Helen F. Albers, daughter of Peter and Isabel (Schaben) Frederick, was born May 6, 1922, on a farm near Earling. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Earling. She attended St. Joseph's Catholic School and graduated with the class of 1940.

Helen married Herman Albers May 3, 1943, at St. Joseph's Church at Earling. They were engaged in farming until 1952 when they moved to Omaha, NE.
