

## **James Albers, 64**

*Nov. 19, 1938 - June 4, 2003*

**WOODBINE** – James "Jim" Alan Albers was born Nov. 19, 1938, in Earling, to Alois and Luella (Sasges) Albers. He grew up in Earling and graduated from the Catholic school. In May of 1958, he joined the United States Air Force. He was honorably discharged in 1962. He farmed and raised hogs with his dad and also operated heavy equipment with GA Finley Construction. His other jobs included a gas station mechanic, and working for Wells Fargo. Jim was currently the plant manager for Hallett Materials.

In 1983, Jim married Georgia Ann Haner. The couple lived in Woodbine. Jim died June 4, 2003, at Immanuel Hospital in Omaha, NE, at age 64 years, six months and 16 days.

He is preceded in death by his parents and his sister, Jeanine Graeve. He is survived by his wife, Georgia Ann of Woodbine; daughter, Gemma (Marvin) Owen of Woodbine; son, Scott Kuhlman, and his fiancée, JoAnn Barnum of Harlan; three grandchildren; one brother, John "Jack" Albers (Pat) of Council Bluffs; and other relatives.
