GRAND ISLAND, NE – Reuel G. Andersen was born December 17, 1925 at Harlan, IA the son of John and Ida (Pedersen) Andersen. He was raised on a farm near Harlan, IA where he graduated from Harlan High School with honors in 1943. He attended Commercial Business College and the University of Nebraska-Omaha. He served in the United States Navy during WWII.

Reuel married Carolyn Campbell on October 12, 1963. They lived in Omaha, Humboldt, TN, and Council Bluffs, before moving to Grand Island in 1976. Reuel worked for Delicious Foods in Grand Island from December 1976 until he retired in December 1992 as Vice President of Production. He was a member of the First Baptist Church. Reuel enjoyed fishing, camping, wood-working, caning, NASCAR (both watching and attending), and helping people. He was a sports enthusiast. He died Tuesday, June 17, 2008 at age 82.

Services were held at 10:30 a.m. Saturday at the First Baptist Church in Grand Island. Burial was in the Grand Island Cemetery with military honors. Visitation was from 3-7 p.m. Friday at All Faiths Funeral Home.
