Donald "Mick" Anderson, 67

April 11, 1930 - May 31, 1997 ✓

San Antonio, TX - Donald Dean "Mick" Anderson was born in Atlantic April 11, 1930 the son of John and Irene Murray Anderson and was one of seven children in the family. He attended school in Atlantic and graduated in 1948. He attended Northwest Missouri State College in Maryville, MO until entering the Marine Corps and served during the Korean War, after which he returned to college and graduated from Northwest Missouri State College.

He married Virginia McLaughlin Oct. 11, 1958 at Avoca. He was involved in the meat industry and they made their home in Omaha, NE for a number of years. They lived in several cities until 1979 when they moved to San Antonio, TX. He died in San Antonio May 31, 1997 of an apparent heart condition at age 67 years, one month and 20 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents and two brothers; Wayne and Tommy Anderson. He is survived by his wife Virginia, his mother-in-law, Margaret McLaughlin of Walnut, three brothers; Bill Anderson (Barbara) of Omaha, NE, Dick Anderson (Dianne) of Red Oak, Robert Williams (Janice) of Atlantic, and one sister, Sally (Earl) Turnure, Jr. of Independence, MO, nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held June 4, 1997 at the St. Patrick's Catholic Church with Fr. Fred Reischl officiating. Burial was in the St. Patrick's cemetery, Walnut. Military graveside services were by the Walnut American Legion & Am Vets Posts.
