

## Angelia Atkinson, 86

May 30, 1913 - Nov. 14, 1999

**HARLAN** - Angelia Berniece Atkinson, daughter of Maude (Ruckman) and Robert Donahoe, was born May 30, 1913, in Griswold. She was baptized Feb. 15, 1914, and later confirmed at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Griswold. She attended Griswold Elementary and Griswold High School.

March 29, 1933, she married Floyd Atkinson. To this union five children were born. The couple farmed at Pleasant Ridge before moving to Lewis, and then to Harlan, in 1953, where they later retired. She shared her home with her mother-in-law, Etta Atkinson, until her death in 1966. She died Nov. 14, 1999, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 86 years, five months and 15 days.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Floyd "Shorty" Atkinson; her daughter, Lorelei Martin; her son, Michael Atkinson; her sister, Beulah Doolittle; her brother, Joseph Donahoe; her grandson, Jeffrey Scott Martin; her sons-in-law, Dick Barnett and Kenneth Martin; and a daughter-in-law, Anna Mae Atkinson.
