SHELBY - Larry Lee Boeck was born near Tennant, March 9, 1937. He was the son of Rudolph and Helen Kiesel Boeck and was one of six children. He attended school in Shelby and graduated with the class of 1956. Soon after graduation he began working with the Rock Island Railroad. He continued to work with the Rock Island until they became Iowa Interstate Railroad and was presently a Section foreman with the railroad.

He was married to Mary Ackart on Aug. 9, 1957 at Shelby. They were the parents of four children. They continued to make their home in Shelby where he was a member of the United Lutheran Church.
