Harlan - Alice Lorene Boldizar, daughter of Vernon L. and Doris Lorene (Drake) Ordway was born Oct. 5, 1932 on an acreage near Brayton. She attended country grade school and graduated in 1950 from the Atlantic High School. She worked with her mother for a short time in the grocery store then worked at the Cass County Memorial Hospital in Atlantic.

Sept. 16, 1961 she married Imre Boldizar at Atlantic. They were the parents of three children. After their marriage, they made their home in Atlantic until 1965, when they moved to Harlan. She stayed home and raised her children until 1970 when she became employed by Variety Distributors. She continued to work for Variety Distributors for twenty-five years until her health failed. She died April 20, 1995 at the Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 62 years, six months and 15 days.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband Imre Dec. 1, 1982, a daughter Debra Luann Sept. 18, 1968 and a brother Donald Ordway. She is survived by her children - Donald Boldizar of Omaha and Darla Richardson of Avoca; two grandchildren and other relatives.

Funeral services were held April 23, 1995 at Pauley Funeral Home with Rev. David Polich officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Roger Richardson, Larry Blaine, Ron Holm, Donald Weddle, Dennis Baldwin and Ron Lefeber casket bearers.
