## Iowa Booth, 86

**HARLAN** - Iowa Spurgeon Booth, daughter of Nels and Mary (Klinkefus) Juhl was born June 17, 1902 at Harlan. She died at Myrtue Memorial Hospital, Harlan, May 31, 1989 at age 86 years, 11 months and 14 days.

She attended school in Harlan and grew to adulthood here. June 12, 1920, she married David Kemper Booth in Co. Bluffs. Two daughters were born to this union. After their marriage, they resided in Harlan until about 1940, when they moved to CA., for approximately six years before returning to Harlan. After the death of Kemper in 1973, she continued to reside in her own home until 1977, when she became a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home. She was a member of the Congregational United Church of Christ of Harlan.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by a daughter, Mary Plumb. She is survived by a daughter, Lila (Mrs Mark) Schribner of Sacramento, CA.; a son-in-law, Max Plumb of Harlan; three grandchildren; six great grandchildren and other relatives.
