

Clinton Andrew Bothwell, 68

Oct. 16, 1926 - June 20, 1995

Shelby - Clinton Andrew Bothwell was born near Shelby Oct. 16, 1926. He was the son of John and Mary Marshall Bothwell and was one of two children in the family. He attended school in Shelby and graduated with the Class of 1944.

He married Patricia Owen June 18, 1950 at Clarinda. They made their home on the Bothwell family farm near Shelby. They were the parents of two children, Cindy and Daniel. Clinton farmed his entire adult life and was also a livestock producer and feeder. He was given the Century Farm Award in 1988. She died April 14, 1989. He was an active member of the United Methodist Church in Shelby and for many years, they were sponsors of the MYF of the church. He was a long term member of the Shelby County Fair Board from which he recently retired, was a member of Masonic Lodge #371 AF & AM, a member of the Shriners and participated in many community activities. He died June 20, 1995 at the Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan following an apparent heart attack at age 68 years, 7 months and 24 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents and his wife, Patricia. He is survived by his children, Cindy Peters of Minden and Daniel Bothwell (Mary) of Shelby, four grandchildren; a sister, Hester Ashby of Leawood, KS; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held June 24, 1995 at the United Methodist Church, Shelby with Pastor Dick Krambeck officiating. Burial was in the Shelby Cemetery.
