PORTSMOUTH – Anna Margaret Bruck, daughter of John and Margaret (Schmitz) Bruck was born at Earling, April 17, 1905. She died at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan, Feb. 26, 1989, at age 83 years, 10 months and nine days.

She was baptized at St. Joseph's Catholic Church, Earling and at age three years, moved with her parents to a farm near Portsmouth. In 1918, they moved into Portsmouth where she attended St. Mary's School. After school, she continued to reside with her parents, and cared for them until their death.
