IRWIN — Donald "Sprout" Brundige, son of Warren B. and Kathryn (Poynter) Brundige, was born Aug. 28, 1926, in rural Kirkman. He attended country school in Jefferson twp., and graduated from Manilla High School. He served his country in the Korean Conflict.
