

Pat Buckley, 91

Dec. 7, 1899 — March 3, 1991

PANAMA — Patrick James Buckley, son of James and Philamina (Weegan) Buckley was born Dec. 7, 1899, on a farm northwest of Panama. He was baptized, and confirmed at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Panama. He attended country school, and graduated from Dunlap High School.

Oct. 2, 1922, he married Bernadine Miller Buckley at St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Dunlap. Four children were born to this union. After they were married, they farmed for a few years before moving to his parents farm near Panama. They had been married for 62 and a half years before her death Feb. 24, 1985. He continued to reside on the farm until 1988, when he became a resident of the Little Flower Haven in Earling, where he died March 3, 1991, at age 91 years, two months and 24 days. He was a lifetime member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Panama.

In addition to his parents and wife, he was preceded in death by an infant son and daughter twins; a son, Jerry (P.J.) in 1988; two sisters, Kate and Mary; and three brothers, Tim, Tom, and Mike.

Surviving him is his son, Harold Buckley of Earling; three grandchildren; four great-grandchildren; one brother, Dan Buckley of Harlan; nieces and nephews and other relatives.

A Mass of Christian burial was concelebrated March 6, 1991, at St. Mary's Catholic Church, Panama, with Rev. Chuck Kottas, the celebrant and Rev. Paul Bianchi, concelebrating.
