



## Frances Bushon, 88

**Oct. 21, 1906 - March 8, 1995**

**Omaha** - Frances Bushon, daughter of Peter and Margaret (Fuhs) Jurschak was born Oct. 21, 1906 in Portsmouth. She was the oldest of seven children. Her father and mother farmed their own land with the help of their children. She was quite young when she sustained a broken leg when it was caught in a corn picker. She was educated

enough to be a substitute teacher in the Portsmouth township in the 1920's. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Mary's Catholic church in Portsmouth.

She married Edward Mullink and they were the parents of two daughters. At the age of thirty-nine, she was left widowed with two young daughters, ages ten and seven whom she raised by herself. She worked as a nurse's aide and cleaned private homes.

She later married Charles Bushon. She was a member of St. Peter's Catholic Church in Omaha. She became a resident of Aksarben Manor in 1987. This had been her home until she died March 8, 1995 at age 88 years, four months and 15 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husbands, two sisters and three brothers - Marie Kloek, Peter Jurschak Jr., Margaret Jurschak, John Jurschak and Joseph Jurschak. Frances is survived by her two daughters - Margaret Mary (Louis) Carlentine Sr. of Omaha, NE, Mary Ann (Robert) Dobiesz of Las Vegas, NV; one sister - Gertrude Jurschak of Chicago, IL - seven grandchildren and sixteen great-grandchildren and other relatives.

A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated March 11, 1995 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Portsmouth with Rev. Joseph Kula celebrant. Inurnment was held at St. Mary's cemetery in Portsmouth.
