AUDUBON - Florence Buthweg, daughter of Fred and Mary Musson Buthweg, was born July

13, 1905, at her parents' home in Audubon and died Nov. 30, 1996, at the Friendship Home in Audubon at age 91 years, four months and 17 days. She attended Sunday School at the First Presbyterian Church in Audubon. She attended Audubon Community Schools graduating in 1923. She attended Simpson College in Indianola for one year, then transferred to Cornell College in Mt. Vernon, and graduated in 1927 with a Bachelors Degree in History. She taught high school history in Anita, Parkersburg, Manning and then taught in the Harlan Public School for 25 years. In 1969, she returned from teaching then traveled across the U.S. and Canada with her brother, Harold. They maintained their home until they became residents of the Friendship Home in May of 1993. She had been a member of the Order of the Eastern Star since graduating from high school and was a member of the Delta Kappa Gamma Sorority.

Preceding her in death were her parents; her brother, Harold M. Buthweg; aunts; uncles and other relatives. Survivors include her relatives.

Funeral services were conducted by Dr. Jerry Binns Dec. 3, 1996, at the First Presbyterian Church in Audubon. Burial was in the Arlington Heights Cemetery in Audubon. Casket bearers were Donald Christensen, Leroy Christensen, Alton (Skip) Dale, Charles Goeken, Richard Petersen and Larry Turner.
